

RESIDENCY-YEAR IN PALLIATIVE MEDICINE – ENHANCED SKILLS

The Division of Palliative Care Medicine, Department of Oncology, University of Alberta is offering a fully funded one-year Program of Enhanced Skills in Palliative Medicine, accredited by the College of Family Physicians of Canada. The program is open to physicians who have completed requirements for certification. Clinical experiences will include a specialist palliative care unit, consultation services in the home, hospices, and acute care hospitals, and outpatient clinics. Residents also participate in a didactic seminar program and complete a scholarly project.

For the academic year of July 2019/20, interested individuals are asked to have their applications in (preferably, electronically) by the 5th October 2018, interview dates will be on the 22nd November with an offer date of 6th December and acceptance date by 14th December. Applying after these dates will be based on availability.
