Policy on publication of CSPCP projects/work

If a CSPCP Member or Board member wishes to submit a manuscript for publication that is substantially about a CSPCP project or other work conducted by the CSPCP, he/she must request approval of the manuscript from the CSPCP Board before the publication is submitted.

The requirement for Board sign-off is waived if:

1. The content was extracted from a CSPCP report that was approved by the Board. In this case, the manuscript must be approved by the Executive Director of the CSPCP and at least one Board member who participated on the project.
2. The manuscript references a CSPCP project but the bulk of the manuscript is not about the project

To request approval: Submit a draft of the manuscript and the name of the intended publication to ed@cspcp.ca. You will receive a response within 14 days.

If the manuscript is approved by the Board and if it is subsequently accepted by the publisher, the CSPCP will reimburse up to \$100 for the submission fee (if applicable).
