

## Palliative Care Physician Opportunities

**Fraser Health has several openings for full-time and part-time Palliative Care Physicians.** The successful physician applicant will serve as a member of a local palliative care consultation team and responsibilities may include consultation support for patients and families in community as well as hospital settings and time as a most responsible physician within designated palliative care and Hospice residence settings. Specific responsibilities and location of services would be negotiated.

Our comprehensive regional palliative care network ensures patients and families with serious illness have access to the supports and services they require. We serve over 6000 patients a year with access to 30 Palliative Complex Care beds; 113 Hospice beds; and consultation support in 12 acute care sites as well as in the community. In addition, we also provide under-graduate and post-graduate teaching in affiliation with the University of British Columbia.

The successful candidate will have completed a year of added competency program in palliative medicine and will have acquired the Certificate of Added Competence (CAC) through the College of Family Physicians of Canada OR have a minimum of three (3) years of palliative care experience and be eligible for the CAC through the current competence verification route.

Eligibility for medical licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia is required, and preference will be given to candidates certified by the College of Family Physicians of Canada or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

Remuneration is by service/sessional contract at a rate commensurate with skills and experience.
