## Policy on presentation of abstracts on behalf of the CSPCP

If a CSPCP Member or Board member wishes to submit and present an abstract about a CSPCP project or other work conducted by the CSPCP, he/she must request approval of the abstract from the CSPCP Board <u>before</u> the abstract is submitted.

To request approval: Submit a draft of the abstract and details about the conference (date, location, approximate number of attendees, audience) to <a href="ed@cspcp.ca">ed@cspcp.ca</a>. You will receive a response within 14 days.

If the abstract is approved by the Board, and it is subsequently accepted by the meeting organizers, the authorized presenter may request up to \$500 reimbursement of expenses related to the abstract, such as: conference registration, travel and accommodation to attend the conference, printing of a poster. The reimbursement applies only to external conferences (not to ALPM).
