Description:

The Department of Family and Community Medicine, Division of Palliative Care at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre is recruiting palliative care physicians to work in our palliative care unit, outpatient clinics (malignant and non-malignant clinics) and on our inpatient consult service starting July 2023. There are more than one position available, with both full-time and part-time opportunities available.

Located in midtown Toronto, Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre (SHSC) is a fully affiliated hospital of the University of Toronto. The institution supports the Odette Cancer Centre, one of the largest cancer centers in the country, one of the largest ALS clinics in the country, and is the largest stroke and trauma center in Ontario.

The Division of Palliative Care at SHSC supports a 56 bed palliative care unit, a robust inpatient consult service, and ambulatory care clinics in cancer, heart failure, ALS, and renal failure, with plans to expand further.

The successful candidate should hold an MD or equivalent, and be eligible for a clinical appointment at the University of Toronto. The candidate should have completed post-graduate training in a recognized program in Palliative Medicine, must be eligible for medical licensure in the Province of Ontario and hold active CMPA membership.

The responsibilities of the successful candidate will include provision of excellent clinical care and clinical teaching to undergraduate and postgraduate learners. The individual must be a strong team player and have demonstrated a commitment to academic scholarship. Research, QI, or leadership interest is an asset. Academic rank will be commensurate with the candidate's qualifications and experience.

The anticipated start date is July 2023, but may be flexible. The closing date for applications is January 6, 2023 although the positions will remain open until filled.
