



**Lecturer or Assistant / Associate / Full Professor – Palliative Medicine Physician
Department of Medicine, St. Michael's Hospital and University of Toronto**

The Departments of Medicine at St. Michael's Hospital and University of Toronto Temerty Faculty of Medicine are seeking a qualified full-time academic physician with advanced training in palliative medicine. The successful candidate must be eligible for a Full-time Clinical Academic appointment at the rank of Lecturer or Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor at the University of Toronto. The candidate will have an academic position description of Clinician Teacher (CT) or Clinician in Quality and Innovation (CQI). The expected start date of the position is October 1, 2023, or shortly thereafter.

The successful candidate will hold an MD degree and have, or be eligible for, certification in Palliative Medicine and/or Internal Medicine by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO). The successful candidate must have advanced training in palliative medicine and proven clinical excellence in the various aspects of palliative care. Preferably, the successful candidate will also have or be working towards a graduate degree relevant to their area of specialization. Experience in program development, leadership and/or curriculum development will be assets. The successful candidate will participate in the educational programs in Palliative Medicine at St. Michael's Hospital and the University of Toronto and may collaborate in clinical research and quality improvement programs. The successful candidate will report to the Head, Division of General Internal Medicine at St. Michael's Hospital. Clinical activities will include attending on the inpatient service, participating in the weekend on call rotation schedule as well as consults for in-hospital patients on other services. There will also be opportunities to participate in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching and quality improvement activities in conjunction with clinical work.

Estimated remuneration will be commensurate with academic rank, qualifications and experience, and is conservatively estimated to be in the range of \$275,000 to \$350,000 per annum based on fee for service billings. A comprehensive extended health and dental benefit program is included. The successful candidate may be eligible for relocation benefits. All candidates must be able to function proficiently in English. Applications will be accepted until May 15, 2023 or until the position is filled.
