The Department of Medicine at SHN is seeking a Palliative Care Physician to join our team at SHN and with the Palliative Care Community Team (PCCT) based out of the Scarborough Centre for Healthy Communities. As a staff palliative care physician, you will provide consultation and care in the acute hospital setting, outpatient clinics, as well as home visits. There may also be a possibility for work in the Palliative Care Unit or Hospice setting. The successful candidate will be expected to join regular department meetings, participate in the education of medical trainees, as well as contribute to the development and growth of the palliative care program. Participation in the call schedule is also expected.

The successful candidate should hold an MD or equivalent, be eligible for medical licensure in Ontario (CPSO), and be eligible for a clinical appointment at the University of Toronto. The candidate should have completed additional training in Palliative Care or have a Certificate of Added Competency. Emphasis will be placed on candidates with palliative care experience and strong communication skills. Preference will be given to candidates with a background in Internal Medicine or Family Medicine. Excellent interpersonal skills and a commitment to inter-professional care are essential.

All appointments are subject to an Impact Analysis and Board approval. The hospital reserves the right not to appoint anyone to this position.
