

The Department of Family Medicine, Division of Palliative Care is seeking 2 Full Time Palliative Care Physicians

To work in a multidisciplinary team environment along with 13 other Palliative Care Physicians to provide consultation for patients in multiple settings including: Outpatient Supportive & Palliative Care Clinic, the Inpatient Medical Oncology/Palliative Unit, Long Term Care, Hospice, Survivorship, Virtual Palliative Care, and in the community. The physicians will share in the provision of on-call coverage for both the inpatients and community patients under the team's care. Remuneration is fee-for-service as set up by the OHIP Schedule of Benefits and Fees and HOCC stipends for participating in the Hospital On-Call Coverage program. Physicians will collaborate with regional partners and participate in a regional network of Palliative Care providers for education and collective growth.

Osler is an integral clinical partner in the development of Ontario's New Medical School, in partnership with Toronto Metropolitan University (TMU) and as part of its transition to an Academic Health Centre. In addition, we are an affiliated Academic Community Teaching Site for the McMaster University Michael G. DeGroote School of Medicine; Family Medicine Program, and there is ample opportunity to participate in clinical education with medical students and residents. Osler is also an officially designated site for the training of Royal College sub-specialty in Palliative Medicine and ESMO designated site of Integrated Oncology/Palliative Care.

The preferred candidates must have a Certificate of Registration to practice from the College of Physicians & Surgeons of Ontario and hold a fellowship from the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada, or certificate in Family Medicine from the College of Family Physicians of Canada. A certificate of added competency in Palliative Medicine is a requirement.
